The training consists of the following:

Day 1 Travel - Equipment check and classroom set up.

A Point Repair Kit is opened, laid out, and explained.

A "dry run" of the procedure is then performed, followed by a complete wet out of the liner and an above ground installation into the PVC pipe with the carrier.

Lunch is taken while the curing process takes place.

After lunch the crew will wet out and complete another above ground installation.

Day 3 Field Training. Your crew will begin to do 3 supervised in-ground repairs. This necessary exercise provides valuable hands on field experience.

Day 4 Completion of the in-ground repairs. This is the final day, weather permitting.

Upon completion of training you will receive at no additional charge, the Infrastructure Repair Systems, Inc. training process on a DVD to train new crewmembers or refresh your crew when needed.
